## WHISTLE BLOWING NEWS

Week 2 morning games were umpired by Jenni, Sarah D, Danielle, Tegan, Nicole, Sofie, Rachel, Georgia and myself – thanks to all, another week of great umpiring!

It was Georgia's first game and she did a FANTASTIC job. Well done, Georgia – you looked confident, made some great calls, had a loud voice and whistle, and you even seemed to be having fun!

Thanks also to Sarah Carman, a National "C" Umpire, for coming out early to support our junior umpires this week. It is always great to get a few tips from one of Gazelles finest umpires!

Just a reminder to all umpires that I would like to have a copy of your section 1 Online Exam once you have passed. I also forward a copy onto BHSNA for their records. I have now placed a green folder into the Gazelles crate in the Gazebo (labelled Junior Umpiring) that you may use to forward your certificate, or anything else, onto me. Also in this folder I have placed a couple of copies of the Rule Book and U for Umpiring Book. If anyone (umpire, player or parent) would like to borrow a copy, please feel free to do so. I just ask that you fill out the "borrowing" sheet in the folder so that I know where they are.

I would also like to remind all umpires to use a LOUD voice and a LOUD whistle on every call you make. It is really important that you can be heard by all players and the other umpire. There is so much noise out at Kellyville that you almost need to be yelling before you can be heard! I would also like to see all umpires using a hand signal to indicate the direction of play on each call (eg if it is a Gazelles free pass, hold your arm out in the direction of the Gazelles Goal end as you make your call). This will help the players to understand your call and also keep the game flowing. I will be focusing on this over the next couple of weeks, and will be giving feedback to all morning umpires.

Have a great Easter Break and I look forward to seeing you all in cooler weather after the Holidays.

All other age groups use the standard Size 5, but it is important that our little girls are using the smaller size.
