Player Requirements

The following requirements are set and you may be asked to leave the court or not start at all if these requirements are not met:

SOCKS — it is an Association requirement that socks cover the player's ankle. Players can be removed from the court if their socks do not comply. Please do not wear those tiny socks that cannot be seen in runners.

HEAD GEAR — any headbands or pony tail accessories must be soft. Please do not wear plastic headbands or hard hair ties.

CAPS — baseball caps cannot be worn on the courts due to the hard visor. Soft visors are available from the canteen at netball or for cheaper through the Sydney Netball Shop in Anella Ave, Castle Hill (opposite the RTA). We have previously accepted dark green or navy visors but with the new uniform navy would be preferable.

FINGERNAILS — to assist the coaches, would parents please ensure the player's fingernails are clipped short before each game.

JEWELLERY — no earrings or other jewelry is acceptable on the court at any time. Everything must be removed before the game.
