"Beginning Coaching" Course

The Australian Sports Commission is pleased to announce the launch of a new online course for coaches. FREE The Beginning Coaching General Principles online course has been developed to assist new coaches improve their basic coaching skills, in particular, those coaches working with children.

Coaches can complete the course in their own time, from the comfort of their own home. It is initially being made available free of charge to Australian coaches by the Australian Sports Commission.

The course contains 5 modules, covering a range of general coaching topics, including the role and responsibilities expected of a coach, planning, safety, working with parents, communication, group management. The course takes approximately 6 hours to complete with assessment included at the end of each module. <https://learning.ausport.gov.au>
