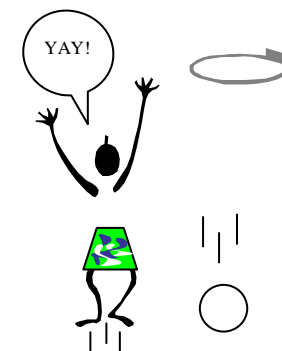

### **Umpiring Tip of the Week**

A player may stand closer to an opponent without the ball provided their arms are not extended, but a player may not use intimidating actions against an opponent with or without the ball. Intimidation is when the defending player blocks the natural shot of the ball by the shooter by standing too close but not defending with arms.
