BHSNA — MAY 2011 COUNCIL MEETING — REGISTRAR'S REPORT

BORROWING

Despite numerous requests being made to all clubs, there are still a large number of people not recording borrowed players on the scoresheet correctly. This causes a huge workload at control for those who have to search through all teams to find where a player has been borrowed from. As a result, and in an effort to be fair to those who take the time to record borrowed players correctly, from now on if a borrowed player is not recorded correctly, no points will be allocated for that game until the issue is cleared up by the offending team. The members of the Competition Committee will no longer search for borrowed players on behalf of teams. If this measure does not result in an improvement, a fine will be considered for offending teams.

Correct procedures for recording borrowed players:

The player's name must be recorded in the list of players who take the court AND at the bottom of the sheet in the "Borrowed players" box. Beside their name in the "Borrowed Player's" box the manager/scorer must also record the team from which the player has been borrowed. The correct spelling of the player's name and the team they play in can be found on the player's card which must be at the court at the time of the borrowed player taking the court. If the original card is not available a copy may be borrowed from control if your club has supplied copies.

there will be immediate penalties of points not being allocated as Control is no longer searching through teams for borrowed players so just will not allocate the points received by the team who borrows and does not record the details properly.. Maybe if people are borrowing and are not sure what to do, find someone who is. There is usually someone around the gazebo, especially in the afternoons.

MODIFIED RINGS

Three modified rings were borrowed on Saturday (30th April) and not returned. As a result we no longer have spare rings so if anyone forgets their ring they have to play without it. The one remaining modified ring must stay in the same goal post for the entire game due to OHS regulations for ensuring safety. Please ensure that the rings are taken at the conclusion of the game so they are not lost.

Please ensure that the bins are not brought in until after the conclusion of the 3.40 games, and all rubbish and lost property is collected at the same time, thus leaving the courts in a spotless state.
